

### Sierra Mountain Quilters Association General Meeting Minutes, September 4, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by president, Sue Johnson, at the Oakhurst Community enter followed by the flag salute. Sue thanked the greeters and table decorators and then recognized August birthdays and anniversaries. Sue announced the February 2026, meeting will be moved to February 12, and starting next month all meetings will begin at 1:00 p.m. Penni Simily made a motion, Laura Gonzalez seconded, to accept the August 7, 2025, general meeting minutes. The motion carried.

First Vice Presidents, Joan Earnest and Sally Walker, announced Lynn Gray and Joanie Madaus will teach a padded folding chair class tomorrow. In October, Cindy Young will present a trunk show. The next day, Nani Johnson will teach a Retreat Bag class. In November, Kim Brownell will present a "Wacky Doodle Quilter" trunk show. Dec. 4 will be the Winter Luncheon at Bee's Bakery.

Second Vice President, Bev Gulley, reported on the document review committee. The results will be reported to the board at the September meeting.

Treasurer, Lisa Kernaghan, had no report. The treasurer's report will be filed for audit.

Membership, Lynn Gray for Ku'ulei Arredondo, reported there are 38 members attending with 2 guests. Currently we have 99 members.
