Yardage and Cutting Directions

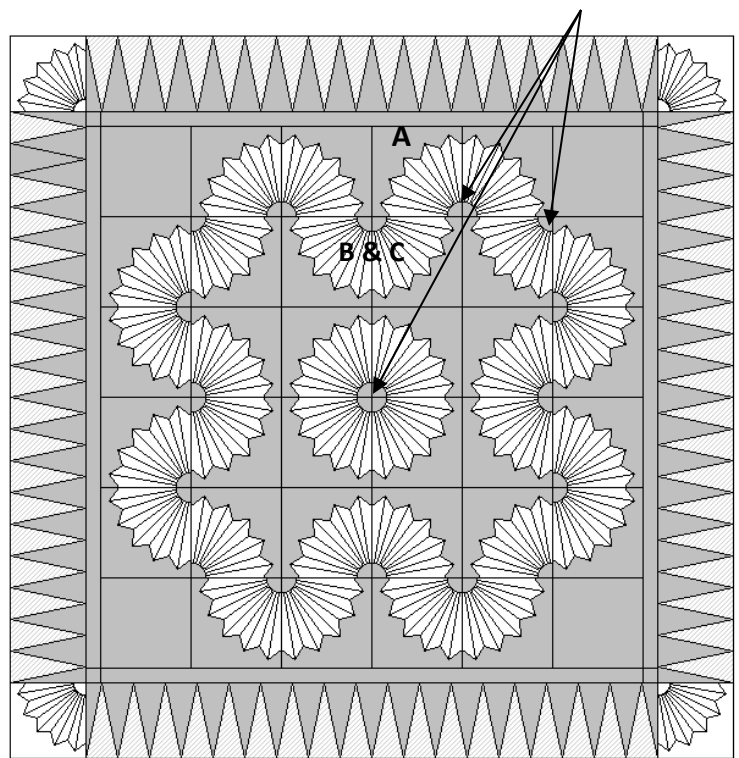
Placement	Colors	Yardage Amount
A Block Background Inner Border Center Circles Blades for outer Border	Black	2 yds
B Dresden Split Blades	Light	20 2 ½" Strips or 1 ½ yards Total 10 different colors Jell Roll works well
C Dresden Split Blades	Dark	20 2 ½" Strips or 1 ½ yards Total 10 different colors to match Light Jelly Roll works well
D Backing	Multi	3 Yards
Batting		52" by 52"

*Note Dresden Blades- The quilt photo was done with a roll of precut strips.

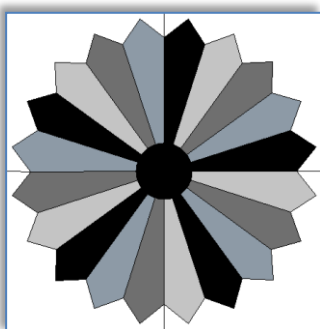
Center Circles

Other Supplies

Pattern (I will bring to class)
Thread to blend with fabrics for piecing
Freezer Paper
Water Soluble fabric glue
Basic sewing supplies - scissors, seam ripper pins etc.
Rotary Cutting Tools: Ruler, Cutter & Board
Finger Pressing Tool
Fabric turning tool such as Purple Thang
Scissors for Paper and Plastic
Mechanical Pencil
Finishes at approx 48" by 48"
Dresden Ruler by fast2cut (Optional)
Sewing machine
Fabric Marking Pen or Pencil
Starch and small paintbrush
Small iron and pressing surface

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Do Before Class

Please precut Block Background and the 2 1/2" strips needed for the Split blades. Sew strips together in pairs and press seams open. You will not need all the blades in class so you can sew 2 - 4 pairs together and that will be enough for class.

(We will cut blades in class.)

Cutting Directions

Strips are cut across the width of the fabric. Strips should be a minimum of 40" long

	Placement	Colors	First Strip Cut	Sub Cut
A	Block Background	Black	6 strips 6 1/2" wide	36 6 1/2" squares
	Inner Border	Black	4 Strips 1 1/2" wide	Length of finished top- as needed
	Quarter, half and Full circles	Black	Use leftover end pieces from strips to cut circles. See Cutting Circles for more instruction	We will cut in class
	Border Blades	Black	4 Strips 5 1/4" wide	We will cut blades in class
B	Dresden Blades for center of quilt & border	Light Colors	Cut 20 2 1/2" strips	Sew strips of light fabrics and dark fabrics together- Press Seams open Cut to 5 1/4" lengths
C	Dresden Blades for center of quilt & border	Dark Colors	Cut 20 2 1/2" strips	
D	Backing	Multi	Pieced to finish at 52" by 52"

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The Color wheel with the white background takes the same fabric and cutting as the Black one.
