Yields 4 blocks.

|  <p>Cottage Garden Aquamarine Fabric 1 17180 24</p> | <p>From 1 fat quarter, cut: 2 - 4 3/4" x 20" strips, cut into A: 12 - 4 3/4" x 1 7/8" </p> |
|  <p>Foliage Aquamarine Fabric 9 17185 24</p> | <p>From 1 fat eighth, cut: 3 - 1 7/8" x 20" strips, cut into B: 24 - 1 7/8" x 1 7/8" </p> |
|  <p>Filagree Cloud Fabric 16 13521 08</p> | <p>From 5/8 yard, cut: 3 - 1 1/2" x WOF strips, cut into C: 8 - 12 1/2" x 1 1/2"  2 - 3 3/4" x WOF strips, cut into D: 12 - 3 3/4" x 3 3/4"  2 - 2 1/4" x WOF strips, cut into E: 24 - 2 1/4" x 2 1/4" </p> |

Symbols & Terms:

WOF = Width of Fabric

 = Squares

 = Rectangles

 = Cut in half, diagonally

 = Cut in quarters, diagonally

Block 4 Piecing Instructions

Yields 4 blocks.

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ "-wide seam allowances. Press after each seam. Pressing suggestions are indicated by the arrows in the assembly diagrams.

For detailed instructions on making the various stitch-and-flip shapes used in this block, see *Stitch-and-Flip Basics* (pages 1-4).

Part 1: Assembling the Center Units

1. Arrange B squares and an A rectangle with D and E triangles in diagonal rows as shown.

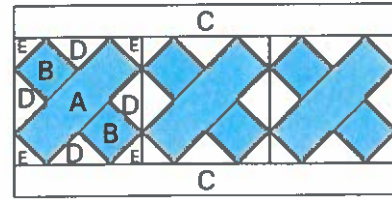
Sew the pieces into 3 rows. Sew the outer E triangles to the top left and bottom right rows.

Then, join the rows together. Center and

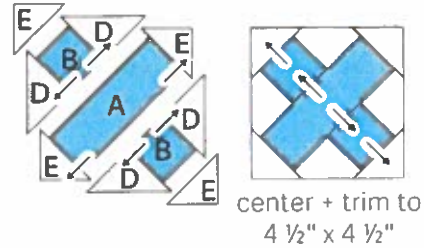
Part 4: Assembling Block 2

trim to $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ". **Make 12.**

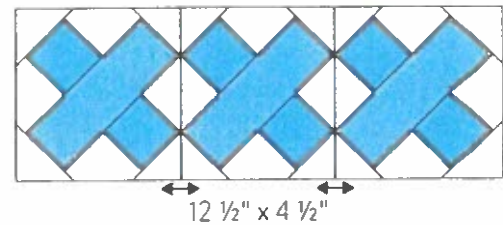
2. Join 3 - Step 1 units into a row. Press seams open to reduce bulk. **Make 4.**
3. Sew C rectangles to the top and bottom edges of a Step 2 unit. **Make 4.**
