The Treasurer's report was approved as printed in the newsletter and the report was filed for audit.


Block of the Month

Each month a different block will be presented at the SMQA meeting along with instructions. You can participate each month or just occasionally. Bring your completed block(s) to the next meeting and you will get a raffle ticket for each block you turn in. When all are turned in there will be a drawing and the winner gets ALL the blocks. You could get 10 or 20 or maybe even 40! They are yours to do with as you choose. Just remember to bring back your completed project so we can see what you did with them.

Block for July Meeting:

Friendship Star

- 4 4.5" white squares
- 2 5" white squares
- 2 5" red squares
- 1 4.5" blue square
- or
- 4 4.5" white squares
- 2 5" white squares
- 2 5" blue squares
- 1 4.5" red square



Layer the 5" white and blue (or red) together. Draw a diagonal line on the white. Sew on $\frac{1}{4}$ " on either side. Cut down the middle. Press towards the blue (or red). Square to 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Join a white 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square on both sides. Make two. Join the remaining two half square triangles to the center 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square (that's either blue or red). Join all three rows as per the illustration. Square to 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Bring them to the July meeting to see if you'll win them all!
