Yields 4 blocks.

 <p>Wild Strawberries Belladonna Fabric 5 17183 86</p>	<p>From $\frac{3}{8}$ yard, cut:</p> <p>1 - 4" x WOF strip, cut into A: 16 - 4" x $2\frac{1}{4}$" <input type="checkbox"/></p> <p>2 - $2\frac{1}{4}$" x WOF strips, cut into B: 32 - $2\frac{1}{4}$" x $2\frac{1}{4}$" <input type="checkbox"/></p>
 <p>Foliage Belladonna Fabric 10 17185 86</p>	<p>From 1 fat eighth, cut:</p> <p>2 - $2\frac{1}{4}$" x 20" strips, cut into C: 16 - $2\frac{1}{4}$" x $2\frac{1}{4}$" <input type="checkbox"/></p>
 <p>Garden Gate Lilac Fabric 14 17186 62</p>	<p>From 1 fat quarter, cut:</p> <p>3 - 4" x 20" strips, cut into D: 4 - 4" x 4" <input type="checkbox"/></p> <p>E: 16 - 4" x $2\frac{1}{4}$" <input type="checkbox"/></p>
 <p>Nightshade Aubergine Fabric 15 13699 86</p>	<p>From 1 fat quarter, cut:</p> <p>6 - $2\frac{1}{4}$" x 20" strips, cut into F: 48 - $2\frac{1}{4}$" x $2\frac{1}{4}$" <input type="checkbox"/></p>
 <p>Filagree Cloud Fabric 16 13521 08</p>	<p>From $\frac{3}{4}$ yard, cut:</p> <p>6 - $1\frac{1}{4}$" x WOF strips, cut into G: 8 - $12\frac{1}{2}$" x $1\frac{1}{4}$" <input type="checkbox"/></p> <p>H: 8 - 11" x $1\frac{1}{4}$" <input type="checkbox"/></p> <p>1 - 4" x WOF strip, cut into I: 16 - 4" x $2\frac{1}{4}$" <input type="checkbox"/></p> <p>3 - $2\frac{1}{4}$" x WOF strips, cut into J: 48 - $2\frac{1}{4}$" x $2\frac{1}{4}$" <input type="checkbox"/></p>

Block 2 Piecing Instructions

Yields 4 blocks.

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ "-wide seam allowances. Press after each seam. Pressing suggestions are indicated by the arrows in the assembly diagrams.







For detailed instructions on making the various stitch-and-flip shapes used in this block, see *Stitch-and-Flip Basics* (pages 1-4).

Part 1: Assembling the Corner Units

1. Sew a C square to the right edge of a J square. Then, sew an I rectangle to the top edge. **Make 16.**

Part 2: Assembling the Side Units

2. Sew J squares to the left and right ends of an E rectangle to make a flying geese unit. **Make 16.**
3. Sew a B square to the lower left corner of a Step 2 unit. Then, sew an additional B square to the lower right corner. **Make 16.**
4. Sew F squares to the left and right ends of an A rectangle to make a flying geese unit. **Make 16.**
5. Join units from Steps 3-4 into pairs, as shown. **Make 16.**



Block 2 Piecing Instructions, Continued

Part 3: Assembling the Center Units

6. Sew F squares to the corners of a D square, as shown, to make a square-in-a-square unit. **Make 4.**

Part 4: Assembling Block 2

7. Arrange the units from Parts 1-3 in 3 rows as shown.

Sew the units together into rows and then join the rows together. **Make 4.**


8. Sew H rectangle to the left and right edges of a Step 7 unit.

Then, sew G rectangles to the top and bottom edges. **Make 4.**
