

Pediatric Wheelchair Bags

- 1 - 7 1/2" x 14" batting
- 1 - 10" x 14" batting
- 40" ribbon, cut in quarters

- 2 - 10" x 14" pieces of fabric (HXW)
- 1 - 15" x 14" piece of fabric (HXW)
- 1 - 9" x 9" piece of fabric

(Figure a) Large Pocket

Place the 15" x 14" fabric wrong side up.
 Place the 7 1/2" x 14" piece of batting on bottom of the fabric.
 Fold over fabric to cover batting.
 Topstitch about 1/4" down from fold line.

Take the 9" x 9" piece of fabric & fold right sides together. Stitch on both sides, leaving bottom open. Turn right side out and press. Topstitch 1/4" from fold line. Press raw edge under 1/4 inch. (Figure b)

Place in center of the 14" x 7 1/2" large pocket piece, opening should be towards the fold line. Edge stitch sides and bottom down to large pocket piece.

Assemble:

Begin by placing the 10" x 14" piece of batting down. (Figure c)
 Place a 10" x 14" piece of fabric on top of batting, right side up. Place the 14" x 7 1/2" large pocket on top of that with small pocket facing out, matching edges and bottom.
 Put ribbon in 2 sets and place each set 1" - 1 1/2" from top outer edge of the bag. Keep the ribbons away from seam lines.

Place the other 10" x 14" piece on top of all this, right side down. Sew all the way around the bag, leaving about a 5" opening for turning at the top, between the ribbon ties. (Figure d)

Clip corners, Turn right side out.
 Press well.
 Topstitch entire top edge.

Please note that pictures are from adult wheelchair bag. Procedure is the same.

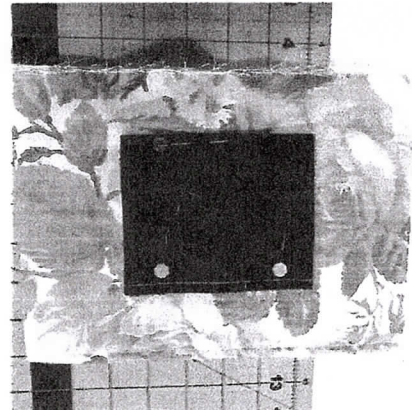

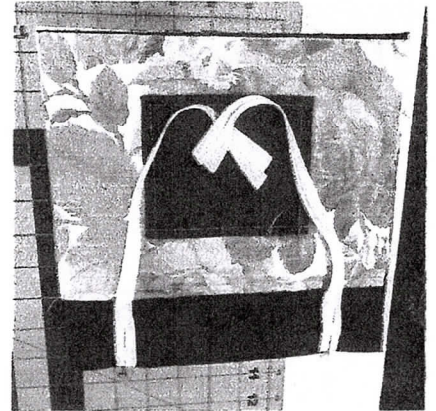

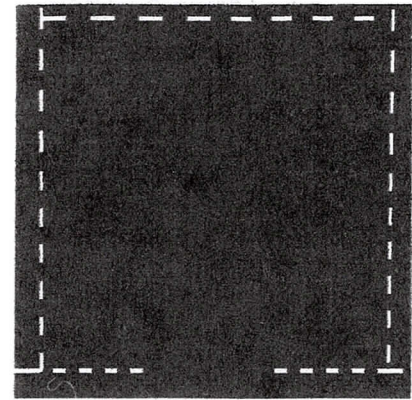
