## Supply List

I will have a selection of different cat and dog patterns to choose from; Bulldog, Boston Terrier, tabby cat and others.

- ½ - 1 yd of lightweight interfacing, something like Pellon 830 / Easy Pattern. Does not need to be fusible, just so you can see through it.
- A variety of colorful fabrics in all values. Small and large pieces including scraps. Include a variety of prints, textures, small and large scale prints, batiks. Some black and white fabric.
- Choose a complimentary color scheme can make choices easier. I encourage sharing of fabrics.
- Pencil, Chalk pencil or similar fabric marking tools. Disappearing ink pen can work. (Bohin chalk pencil)
- Black permanent marker Sharpie Fine (not ultra-fine)
- Scissors, sharp and good for cutting small pieces of fabric. I use KKB 6" perfect scissors
- Alennes Original Tacky Glue or other fabric glue, Can be glue bottle with needle dispenser. Tool for applying glue like a toothpick or I have glue applicators for sale.
- Optional: tweezers and light box
- Background fabric approx ¾ yd I usually chose this after the portrait is made. Look for contrast.
