January 8 & 10 Lura Schwarz Smith is a nationally recognized quilt artist who often works artistically with her husband Kerby. Lura is also a Coarsegold resident and longtime SMQA member. Her lecture will be New Journeys of an Art Quilter and both Lura and Kerby will be showing their work. The Saturday workshop will be on Inking Your Fabric. \$5 material fee. June 4 & 5 Sandra Bruce will share how she came up with her process of gridding a photo called Material Matrix and how it all comes together in fabric using color, design, composition and serendipity. In the workshop of the same name we will use a grid photo she provides of a coffee cup (18" X 20" quilt) to learn her unique technique so we will be able to tackle our own images.
