




Materials & Cutting Instructions

Yields 4 blocks.

	<p>Cottage Garden Cobalt Fabric 2 17180 50</p>	<p>From ½ yard, cut: 3 - 3 ½" x WOF strips, cut into A: 32 - 3 ½" x 3 ½" </p>
	<p>Wild Strawberries Aquamarine Fabric 4 17183 24</p>	<p>From ½ yard, cut: 1 - 3 ½" x WOF strip, cut into B: 4 - 3 ½" x 3 ½"  4 - 2" x WOF strips, cut into C: 64 - 2" x 2" </p>
	<p>Garden Gate Lilac Fabric 14 17186 62</p>	<p>From 1 fat quarter, cut: 2 - 3 ½" x 20" strips, cut into D: 16 - 3 ½" x 2" </p>
	<p>Filagree Cloud Fabric 16 13521 08</p>	<p>From ¾ yard, cut: 1 - 3 ½" x WOF strip, cut into E: 16 - 3 ½" x 2"  8 - 2" x WOF strips, cut into F: 144 - 2" x 2" </p>



Block 3 Piecing Instructions

Yields 4 blocks.





All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ "-wide seam allowances. Press after each seam. Pressing suggestions are indicated by the arrows in the assembly diagrams.

Part 1: Assembling the Corner Units



1. Sew C squares to the upper right and lower left corners of an A square. Then, sew an F square to the lower right corner to make a partial square-in-a-square unit. **Make 16.**
2. Sew an F square to the top edge of a C square. Then, sew that unit to the left edge of a Step 1 unit. **Make 16.**
3. Sew a C square to the right edge of an E rectangle. Then, sew that unit to the top edge of a Step 2 unit. **Make 16.**
4. Sew F squares to the upper right and lower left corners of a Step 3 unit. **Make 16.**



Block 3 Piecing Instructions, Continued

Part 2: Assembling the Side Units

5. Sew F squares to the upper left and right corners of an A square to make a house unit. **Make 16.**
6. Sew F squares to the left and right ends of a D rectangle to make a flying geese unit. **Make 16.**
7. Join units from Steps 5-6 into pairs, as shown. **Make 16.**



Part 3: Assembling the Center Units

8. Sew F squares to the corners of a B square, as shown, to make a square-in-a-square unit. **Make 4.**

Part 4: Assembling Block 2

9. Arrange the units from Parts 1-3 in 3 rows as shown.

Sew the units together into rows and then join the rows together. **Make 4.**
