Jar Quilt Block size 12½" x 12½"

Background Use a light gray, white, cream, tone on tone or small print

- 2 - 2½" x 12½" for side strips
- 2 - 1½" x 8½" for the top and bottom strips
- 2 - 2" x 2½" for the sides of the lid
- 4 - 2" x 2" for the corners

Lid 1 – 2½" x 5½" black, brown, silver, gold, etc. to depict metal

Jar 1 – 8½" x 8½" fabric with flowers, butterflies, dragonflies, etc.....

- Draw a diagonal line on the back of the 4 - 2" squares from corner to corner of the background fabric.
- Place the squares, right sides together, on the corners of the 8½" square piece of jar fabric.
- Sew on the line and flip corner pieces and press.
- Cut the underneath fabrics, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.
- Take the "lid" fabric and sew the 2" x 2½" pieces of background fabric to each side and press.
- Sew the now completed "lid" piece onto the "jar" fabric piece.
- Take the 8½" x 1½" pieces of background and sew to the top and bottom of the jar/lid piece and press.
- Take the remaining 2½" x 12½" pieces and sew to the sides of the jar/lid and press.
- Square it to 12½" x 12½".
- Bring your completed blocks to the September meeting and receive a ticket for each one you turn in. the winning ticket will be drawn before the program. Maybe you'll be the winner of all the blocks. Good luck !
