


















## Materials & Cutting Instructions

Yields 4 blocks.

	<p>Cottage Garden Lavender Fabric 3   17180 60</p>	<p><b>From 1 fat quarter, cut:</b>            2 - 4" x 20" strips, cut into <b>A:</b> 16 - 4" x 2 1/4"             2 - 2 1/4" x 20" strips, cut into <b>B:</b> 16 - 2 1/4" x 2 1/4" </p>
	<p>Garden Gate Cobalt Fabric 13   17186 50</p>	<p><b>From 1 fat quarter, cut:</b>            1 - 4" x 20" strip, cut into <b>C:</b> 4 - 4" x 4"             2 - 3 3/4" x 20" strips, cut into <b>D:</b> 8 - 3 3/4" x 3 3/4" </p>
	<p>Garden Gate Lilac Fabric 14   17186 62</p>	<p><b>From 1 fat quarter, cut:</b>            2 - 4" x 20" strips, cut into <b>E:</b> 16 - 4" x 2 1/4" </p>
	<p>Filagree Cloud Fabric 16   13521 08</p>	<p><b>From 1 yard, cut:</b>            6 - 1 1/4" x WOF strips, cut into <b>F:</b> 8 - 12 1/2" x 1 1/4"   <b>G:</b> 8 - 11" x 1 1/4"             2 - 1 3/8" x WOF strips, cut into <b>H:</b> 16 - 1 3/8" x 4"             1 - 3 3/4" x WOF strip, cut into <b>I:</b> 8 - 3 3/4" x 3 3/4"             2 - 1 3/8" x WOF strips, cut into <b>J:</b> 16 - 1 3/8" x 3 1/8"             5 - 2 1/4" x WOF strips, cut into <b>K:</b> 80 - 2 1/4" x 2 1/4" </p>

## Block 5 Piecing Instructions

Yields 4 blocks.

All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ "-wide seam allowances. Press after each seam. Pressing suggestions are indicated by the arrows in the assembly diagrams.

For detailed instructions on making the various stitch-and-flip shapes used in this block, see *Stitch-and-Flip Basics* (pages 1-4).

### Part 1: Assembling the Corner Units

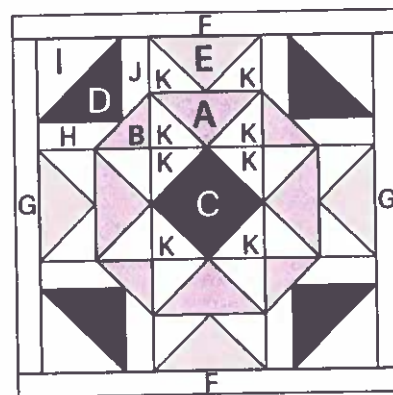
1. Sew together I and D squares to make half-square triangle units.

Center and trim each unit to  $3\frac{1}{8}" \times 3\frac{1}{8}"$ .  
**Make 16.**

2. Sew a J rectangle to the right edge of a Step 1 unit, as shown. Then, sew an H rectangle to the bottom edge. **Make 16.**
3. Sew a B square to the lower right corner of a Step 2 unit. **Make 16.**

### Part 2: Assembling the Side Units

4. Sew K squares to the left and right ends of an E rectangle to make a flying geese unit. **Make 16.**
5. Sew K squares to the left and right ends of an A rectangle to make a flying geese unit. **Make 16.**
6. Join units from Steps 4-5 into pairs, as shown. **Make 16.**

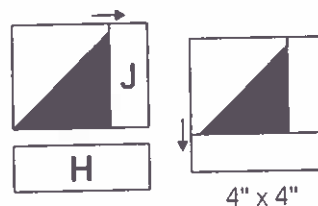

## Block 5 Piecing Instructions, Continued

### Part 3: Assembling the Center Units

7. Sew K squares to the corners of a C square, as shown, to make a square-in-a-square unit. **Make 4.**



### Part 4: Assembling Block 5

8. Arrange the units from Parts 1-3 in 3 rows as shown.

Sew the units into rows and then join the rows together. **Make 4.**

9. Sew G rectangles to the left and right edges of a Step 8 unit. Then, sew F rectangles to the top and bottom edges. **Make 4.**
